Work on the new roof will begin on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> August, and will last for approximately two months. During the work there will be restricted access to the site, and there will be no car parking available on the church car park. Please note that from Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> August, parking is only available on the street, on the school car park and on the football ground at the top of Ostley Bank (but only to the right hand side of the gates – please leave the left hand side clear for the sports club to use). On weekdays parking will be on the street only.

There will be no Mass in Holy Family church on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> August and Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> August.
