<u>Candle Fires:</u> The Diocese insurers have recently issued statistics that show fires involving candles rises dramatically in November through till January, could we all please be diligent in how we control the use of candles at our Churches in Barrow. Below are some very basic requests that may help:

- Try not to leave lit candles burning unattended.
- Always put lit candles on a stable, heat resistant surface
- Place candles away from flammables, allow 3' if under a shelf.
- Do not leave match sticks in candle wax holder.
- Keep votive candles 3" apart when lit.
- Never leave lit candles burning overnight.

Following these simple requests will ensure the safety of our Churches.
