Pope Francis, A man of his word: On Thursday 14th March at 6:30pm in the Parish Centre, we will be showing a film about Pope Francis. Parishioners are encouraged to come along to see this inspirational film that profiles the life of Pope Francis.

Pope Francis, Inspirational Quote from Ash Wednesday: The small mark of ash that we receive is to tell us, with delicacy and truth that of many things on our minds that we chase after and worry about every day nothing will remain. As much as you work on it, you will not bring any wealth with you from this life. Earthly realities will fade away like dust in the wind. Goods are provisional, power passes, success fades. The culture of appearance, so dominant today, that induces us to live for the things that pass, is a great deception. Because it's like a blaze: once finished, only the ash remains. Lent is the time to free ourselves from the illusion of chasing after dust. Lent is for rediscovering that we are created for the inextinguishable flame, not for ashes that immediately disappear, for God, not for the world, for the eternity of Heaven, not for earthly deceit, for the freedom of God, not for the slavery of things. We should ask ourselves today: where do I stand? Do I live for the Fire or for the ash?
