Parish Pilgrimage to Lourdes: Sunday 22nd August-Monday 30th August. We are hoping that this year we are able to travel to Lourdes. Travelling from Barrow by coach to Stansted, overnight stay at Novotel Stansted, return flights to Tarbes (Lourdes Airport), six nights at Hotel Alba full board, includes all taxes. Costs approx. £725 shared room, £875 single room. A non-refundable deposit of £200 is required to book your place. Please contact the Parish Office (Tues-Friday) for an application form. The £200 deposit is only refundable if the governments of France or the UK do not allow us to travel because of the Covid 19 situation or the flight is cancelled. You are responsible for your own travel insurance. **Please could all applications be returned by 6th April.**
