Many of the children who were doing so well at St Joseph's in Marekbodi, have had no access to education for 18 months; a large proportion of them have been working manually on the land and will never return to school. Their families have had no income, the Diocese has exhausted its funds, teachers have not been paid. They need our help, love and prayers more than ever.

On October 3rd I (Clare) will finally get my chance to run the Marathon in London! This year John also has a place so we will be running together.
