Thanks to all who have supported our Mary's Meals concert. It raised £838. We will be sending a donation of £5,449.59 in total which will then be doubled. This will feed and educate 685 children for a year. Thank you.

First Holy Communion:

This will take place in all churches on **Sunday 20th March 2022** for children in **Year 4 and above**. There will be an information meeting for parents who would like their child to make their First Holy Communion on this date.
