**Sacred Heart School:** Please keep the school – children, families and staff in your prayers as following a recent building inspection, the school has had to temporarily close as a precautionary measure to allow further investigation into the condition of the ground floor. The Diocese and the Mater Christi Academy Trust have been working closely with the local authority to find temporary accommodation to enable the children to resume face-to-face learning again. In consequence, an agreement has been reached for Sacred Heart school to temporarily relocate into North Walney Primary School who have the space to accommodate our children. The school will remain separate but will operate from the same building. The school are very grateful to North Walney for stepping in with this offer and to the Headteacher and staff of St Bernard's school for all the support they have given.

The school would also like to thank everyone for all the messages of support and offers of help. It will be a big task to move what is needed over to North Walney and get the classrooms ready for the children to move into so they would be very grateful for volunteers to help over the next couple of weekends if anyone would be willing.
