Sunday 8th and 15th of September Mass Arrangements:

On these two Sundays Fr Nithin is away on his annual leave. In the past Fr Ossie has kindly supplied for us, unfortunately, his health has declined and he is unable to do so now. Since last Sunday, Fr Manny has spoken to other retired priests and the response was that they only supplied locally, in situations that did not require them being away overnight. In consequence, for these two Sunday mornings, we will have to reduce the number of Masses.

Special Minister of the Eucharist Recommissioning: There will be a recommissioning of all Special Minister of the Eucharist at the Masses on Sunday 8th September, including the Vigil Mass.
It is a requirement that all ministers have completed their safeguarding training. Level one for those ministers in Church only and Level 3 for those who take Communion to the sick. Please ensure that you have completed the training before the 7th September. If you are having any difficulty in completing it, please let us know and we will offer and necessary support.
Certificates will be issued to all the recommissioned ministers and these will be valid for two years.
Thank you for your ministry which is such an important part of the life of the parish.

BanktheFood is a registered charity. (Charity Commission for England and Wales Number 1194167)
Food banks often struggle with effectively communicating their real-time supply and demand needs to their donors. Social media posts or notices in supermarkets, quickly go out of date or go unnoticed and as a result, food banks can be inundated with one item or have little of another.
Regularly updating their real-time needs to their local community, can be a cumbersome admin task, which takes food bank volunteers away from their crucial work of collecting and distributing food.
BanktheFood hopes to change this through an innovative free app which links food banks to donors at the most crucial time; when donors are at the supermarket.
Our app is free to use and always will be.
BanktheFood is very simple to use. Download the app from your [app store here](#) and follow the instructions to get started.
Once you have followed your local food bank, the app will send you a helpful 'ping' with a reminder of your food banks' needs when you are shopping in your local supermarket.
You can then choose exactly what you would like to donate and leave your donation in your food bank's collection box at the end of your shopping trip.
Your local food bank will then be alerted via the app of your (anonymous) donation making it easier for your food bank to track and locate items they really need.
