Thank you to everyone who attended last night's meeting. There were 3 areas which were discussed.

1. Shortage of priests
2. Shortage of people attending Mass
3. Financial situation

- There were numerous ideas which largely centred around finance and these will be discussed by the finance committee.
- There was little discussion in regard to the two pastoral issues – lack of priests and lack of attendance at Mass. Clearly there is no obvious solution.
- There is clearly a lot of worry and anxiety in the room at the prospect of closing any Church.
- As the next stage we invite written /email submissions to the parish office (office@olof.org.uk) between now and Sunday 1st December.
- We have formed a working group to study the submissions and will then produce a written response. The working group comprises of 2 members from each Church in addition to the clergy.
- Given the urgency of our financial situation, we don't have much time to come to a decision. By early next year, whatever is decided will have to be submitted to the Bishop and the trustees.

Let us not be despondent. We, the parishioners, are the living stones which make up the Church. What matters above all is Jesus Christ in our midst, supremely in the Eucharist, the Mass, the sacrament of Charity. God Bless.

He will be joined by the Canons of the Cathedral. All the faithful of the Diocese are invited to gather with the Bishop to pray for those priests, now departed, who have shared in your life of faith. The Mass will be followed by the blessing of the Cathedral graveyard. Please make every effort to come if you can.

Centenary Year: As part of the launch of the centenary year of our Diocese the Cathedral will be holding the Forty Hours exposition from **Thursday 21st November until Saturday 23rd November**. The particular intention of this period of prayer will be in thanksgiving for the mission of the Diocese over the last hundred years and seeking God's help for the years to come. The hours of exposition will be as follows:

Thursday 21st November 4pm-12 Midnight

Friday 22nd November 5am-12 Midnight

Saturday 23rd November 5am-6pm (when the exposition will conclude with Benediction)

On the afternoon of **Sunday 24th November** (the opening day of the Centenary year) the Bishop will celebrate Vespers (Evening Prayer) of Christ the King followed by Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 4pm in the Cathedral. During Benediction the Te Deum will be sung in thanksgiving for all the graces bestowed on the Diocese by God during the last century.
