Lent begins with **Ash Wednesday on 5th March.** Mass and distribution of Ashes will be in **St Mary's at 9:30am and 6:00pm**

Stations of the Cross: these will take place every Friday at 12:30pm in St Mary's beginning 7th March and every Wednesday at 6:00pm in St Columba's beginning 12th March.

Adoration, Reflection and Benediction: will take place every Thursday at 6:00pm beginning 13th March.

Lourdes: This year's Parish pilgrimage to Lourdes will take place from **Monday 15**th **September to Saturday 20**th **September 2025.** This is a change to the proposed dates previously advertised due to flight costs. We will be travelling to Stansted on **Sunday 14**th **September,** staying overnight and flying to Lourdes the next day. The cost is approximately **£750 per person sharing or single room rate** approximately **£880.** Price includes transfer to and from Stansted, overnight stay at Stansted on the outward journey, flights (Ryan Air) with priority boarding and 2 bags, hotel with **half board** and transfer between Lourdes airport and Hotel Alba in Lourdes.

Booking forms are available from the Parish office or via email (requests to office@olof.org.uk) and should be returned with a <u>non-refundable deposit</u> of £200 per person (payment details are on the booking form) by Friday 7th March please. Anyone wishing to join the pilgrimage after this date will need to book their own flights.
