Friday 21st March is World Down's Syndrome Day. The theme this year is "Improve our support systems"

In the UK 90% of Down's babies are aborted. In some European countries it is 100%. In the UK a mother has the right to abort a Down's baby up to birth. Pray to improve their lives. Venerable Jerome Lejeune was the scientist who found the faulty gene which causes DS. People often celebrate Down's Syndrome day by wearing coloured mismatched socks. This is because chromosomes look like socks!
