CAFOD: In order to celebrate and commemorate the Jubilee Year, CAFOD and the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales have commissioned an icon from Ethiopian artist, Mulugeta Araya. The icon depicts the scene of Jesus in the synagogue at Nazareth, from the Gospel of Luke, chapter 4, announcing the year of the Lord's favour. The icon will visit **Lancaster Diocese from 26th March to 1st April** and will be on display in the **Lady Chapel at St Peter's Cathedral in Lancaster**. Accompanying the icon are resources for reflecting on different aspects of Jubilee from the scriptures and their relation to stories of people around the world today. Please do come along and visit the icon while it is with us in Lancaster Diocese and spend time in meditative and contemplative prayer, allowing God to speak to us in this Holy Year. To help you to reflect on the meaning of this special year, CAFOD will be hosting a short prayer and reflection time with the icon in the **Lady Chapel after the 12.15pm weekday Mass on Wed 26th March, Thurs 27th March, Mon 31st March and Tues 1st April**.
