Church Closures: Bishop Paul has issued the decrees pertaining to the closures of Sacred Heart and St Columba Churches. The date of issue was the 10th September 2025 and the final Masses are proposed for **Sunday 28th September.**

Parishioners have a right to appeal the decision within 10 working days and appeals must be made for a compelling reason. The decrees are posted on the noticeboards at the back of all Churches and individual copies are also available.
