Please note: on **Wednesday 15th October** there will be Eucharistic Adoration and Rosary at **St Mary's** in place of Mass. **Mass on Saturday 18th October** will be at the earlier time of **9:00am because of the Centenary Mass at Lancaster Cathedral**.

October Rosary: During the month of October, we will be reciting the rosary for peace in our world. The first recitation will be **on Monday 13th October at 7:00pm in St Mary's**. For those who are unable to attend in person, it will be live-streamed. We hope that this will be an opportunity to pause together, whether in Church or at home and pray to Our Blessed Lady, Queen of Peace.

Chamber Music Concert: Friday 17th October, 7:00pm in St Mary's.

A string orchestra led by Sam Kane, will be performing music by Elgar and Holst and Fr Manny will join them to perform Eclogue for piano and orchestra by Gerald Finzi. The young musicians of the orchestra are extremely gifted and in the beautiful setting of St Mary's it promises to be a wonderful concert.

Transport to Church:
